# **SPRING 2024** INTERNATIONAL ADMISSIONS PROCEDURE

# Step 1 – Online Application Complete application online: <a href="https://southlands.wufoo.com/forms/international-student-application-part-i/">https://southlands.wufoo.com/forms/international-student-application-part-i/</a> Pay \$250 application fee online Upload official transcript of most recent years High school applicants are required to upload all transcripts from 9th grade. 11th/12th grade all transcripts from 9th grade must be uploaded for evaluation in advance Upload passport copy Online Zoom interview: Must download Zoom on a computer Evidence of English Proficiency (TOEFL/IELTS/Duolingo/TOEFL Jr.): Depends on the grade applied

## <u>Step 2 – Registration (After Acceptance)</u>

- ☐ Provide Evidence of Funds: (No less than \$35,000)
- Pay a \$650 registration fee and a \$5,000 Reserved Seating Security Deposit. The deposit amount may vary after the application deadline.
- ☐ The I-20 form will be sent to the parents and/or guardians only

(Pay a \$130 shipping fee if you want us to mail you the hard copy of the I-20 form. According to the current policy, the printed ecopy I-20 is accepted for the visa interview and the entrance to the US.)

### Step 3 - F1 Visa (Action Relating to Embassy/Consulate)

- ☐ Pay I-901 Fee Online at: https://www.fmjfee.com/i901fee/index.html
- ☐ Schedule appointment with the U.S Embassy for F1 Visa (must bring I-20 Form & proof of I-901 fee payment)
- ☐ Provide the visa appointment confirmation letter within 7 days of receiving the I-20.
- ☐ The following circumstances will result in the cancellation of the I-20:
  - -Non-submission of the visa interview confirmation letter within 7 days.
  - -Provision of inaccurate, false, or outdated visa interview information.
  - -Visa rejection; (in case of denial, timely communication with the school is necessary for reapplication.)

### **Step 4– Actions after Passing the Visa Interview**

- ☐ Submit all required documents (immunization record, notarized guardianship authorization form, etc.)
- ☐ Pay tuition within one week after the visa is granted
- ☐ Provide an F1 Visa copy & arrival date to the International Admissions Office
- ☐ Attend mandatory placement exam day and orientation
- ☐ Students can only begin classes once all required documents have been submitted to the school
- All fees are subject to change
- All fees are non-refundable
- The \$5,000 reservation seat deposit is eligible for a refund only if the most recent visa interview, as indicated on the U.S. government website, results in a visa denial
- All documents provided must be in translated in English
- Forged documents will result in automatic rejection
